recommendation of the State Govt. vide Memo

w.e.f. 01-05-2008 without financial assistance
from Govt.

Dear Sir,

I am directed to inform you that the President, W.B. Board of Secondary Education in exercise of the powers vested in her u/s 28(2) of the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education Act, 1963, as amended, has been pleased to consider the report and recommendation of the State Govt. vide Memo No.803 -SE(S)/3S-68/07 Dt.10-07-2008 and to grant recognition/upgradation to Bishnupur Public School, Dist- Bankura as a X class High School (Class IX to Class X) without financial assistance from Govt. w.e.f. 01.05.2008 with permission to open Class IX from 2008 and Class X from 2009 provisionally for three years subject to fulfilment of conditions enclosed alongwith the additional condition imposed by the Education Department vide Memo No.803-SE(S)/3S-68/07 Dt.10-07-2008. The School will send up 1st batch of candidates at the Madhyamik Pariksha (Secondary Examination) 2010.

1. That, the school authority shall never claim any financial assistance from State Government.
2. That the School Authority shall implement the prescribed pay scales and allowances for the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school.
3. That the School Authority shall provide retirement benefits to the teaching and non-teaching Staff of the school as per a Death-Cum-Retirement Benefit Scheme.
4. That the Managing Committee of the school shall be constituted with at least three guardian Members, three elected teacher members and one non-teaching staff.
5. That the School Authority shall not enhance tuition fees or charges without prior Permission of the Competent Authority.
6. That the school shall not charge any capitation fee or equivalent to capitation fee by any means.
7. That the recruitment of teachers shall be done in accordance with transparent, merit based criteria to be laid down in the relevant Government Rules /Government Orders and information thereof shall be made available to the State Government, if necessary.

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8. That the funds raised by the School authority, the fees collected and earned income by any other source, shall not be utilized for any other purpose than the welfare of the school and benefit of education of the students and the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school.
9. That no change in the ownership of the school or handing over of property or management of the school and any manner changing or amending the character of the Parent Body shall not be done without prior notice to the State Government.
10. That service of no teaching and non-teaching staff shall be terminated without giving opportunity of being heard by the Competent Authority and without observing due disciplinary proceedings.
11. That the service condition of the teaching and non-teaching staff including provisions of Security of service, disciplinary proceedings and procedure for Appeal shall be implemented in accordance with the directions laid down in the Government Rules/Orders and submitted to the State Government.
12. Violation of all or any of the declaration as in Para No. 1 to 11 in this Affidavit shall form sufficient reason for withdrawal of recognition.
13. The school shall abide by procedure and Rules and legal provision that may be promulgated in this regard.

That school authority should ensure suitable arrangement for prevention and fighting of fire in the school. A report of such action taken is to be sent through concerned D.I. (S.E.) of schools within 15(fifteen) days from receipt of this order.

The school is allowed to admit Class -VIII pass students of recognized 4-class Junior High School or recognized High school on the basis of valid transfer certificate and should get those admitted students registered with the respective Regional Office in prescribed form with requisite fee within due date .

A report in the matter of fulfilment of conditions item-wise and seriatim attached to up-gradation should be forwarded to the Board positively within six months, with a copy to both the Director of School Education, W.B. and District Inspector of Schools(SE).

The conditions attached to this recognition/up-gradation as a High School are to be strictly complied with. In default, the Board reserves the right to cancel or withdraw recognition of the school.

The question of granting extension of the recognition/up-gradation of the school will be considered on fulfilment of conditions attached to this up-gradation.

The school enjoying Board's permission for co-education at the Jr. High School stage, is permitted to introduce co-education in the upgraded classes and the said permission shall run concurrently from Class-V to Class X during the provisional period.
