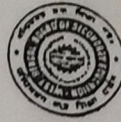
Dear Sir,

I am directed to inform you that the President, Board in exercise of the powers vested in him u/s 28(2) of the W.B. Board of Secondary Education Act, 1963, as amended, has been pleased to consider the report and recommendation of the State Govt. conveyed under the Education Deptt. Letter No. 176-SE(S)/3S-68/2006 and to grant first recognition to **Bishnupur Public School** provisionally for two years as a 4-class Jr. High School (Class-V to Class-VIII) without any financial assistance from Govt. w.e.f. 01.05.2008 subject to normal conditions enclosed along with the additional conditions imposed by the Education Deptt. Vide Memo No. 176-SE(S) dt. 8.2.2008. as stated below:-

1. That, the school authority will never claim any financial assistance from State govt.
2. That, the school authority will implement the Govt. prescribed pay scale and allowances for the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school.
3. That, the school authority shall provide retirement benefits to the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school as per a Death-Cum-retirement Benefit Scheme.
4. That, the Managing Committee of the school shall be constituted with at least three guardian members, three elected teacher members and one non-teaching staff.
5. That, the school authority shall not enhance tuition fees or charges without prior permission of the competent Authority.
6. That the school shall not charge any capitation fee or equivalent to capitation fee by any means.

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WHEN REPLYING, PLEASE QUOTE	
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7. That the recruitment of teachers shall be done in accordance with transparent merit-based criteria as laid down in the relevant Government Rules/Government orders and information thereof shall be made available to the State Government, if necessary.

8. That the funds raised by the school authority, the fees collected and earned income by any other source, shall not be utilized for any other purpose than the welfare of the school and benefit of education of the students and the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school.

9. That no change in the ownership of the school or handing over of property or management of the school and any manner changing or amending the character of the parent Body shall not be done without prior notice to the State Government.

10. That service of teaching and non-teaching staff shall not be terminated without giving opportunity of being heard by the competent Authority and without observing the disciplinary proceedings.

11. That the service condition of the teaching and non-teaching staff including provisions of security of service, disciplinary proceeding and procedure for appeal shall be implemented in accordance with the directions laid down in the Government Rules/Orders and submitted to the State Government.

12. Violation of all or any of the declaration as in para 1 to 12 in the Affidavit shall form sufficient reason for withdrawal of No objection Certificate, or recognition/affiliation, as the case may be.

13. The school shall abide by procedure and Rules and legal provision that may be promulgated in this regard.

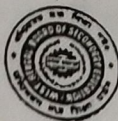
The school authority should ensure suitable arrangement for prevention and fighting of fire in the school. A report of such action taken is to be sent through concerned D.I.(SE) of Schools within 15 (fifteen) days from receipt of this order.

The above recognition is granted subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned herewith.

A report of fulfilment of conditions as per attached sheet should be forwarded to the Board within six months and a copy of such report should be forwarded to the Director of School Education, W.B. and the District Inspector of Schools (SE) concerned.

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: - 3p:-

The existing Organising Committee is permitted to function upto and Administrator/Adhoc Committee, if appointed by the Board, shall also continue to function upto **31-12-2008**. The question of extension of recognition will be considered on receipt of the above report. The conditions to this recognition are to be strictly complied with. In default, the Board reserves the right to cancel or withdraw recognition.
